



Le Moulin de Lecq was one of the many ancient water mills of the island and retains the name it bore over 600 years ago.

Formerly a fuller's mill, with parts of the mill dating back to the 12th century, Le Moulin de Lecq is a historic landmark featuring the largest water wheel on the Island. The Germans later requisitioned the wheel to generate power for their search light batteries throughout the war years until the liberation.

In April 1955 the mill was granted a license, and it was decided to convert it into an 'inn' of unusual character. The outside water wheel weighs 18 tons and has a diameter of 21 feet and works entirely by the weight of water as it did hundreds of years ago. Since then, the property has been run as a genuine free house serving an extensive range of real ales, wines and beers.

A newly built restaurant now adjoins the old mill inn which has been designed in a sympathetic way to blend in with the original stone and masonry craftsmanship. Le Moulin de Lecq prides itself on its informal atmosphere and hopes to provide a welcome and relaxing change to the hustle and bustle of St. Helier.

Champagne & Sparkling Wines

Veuve Clicquot £47.65
Loved all over the world for its crisp, full flavours and consistent quality. This classical dry Champagne is a blend of two-thirds black grapes (Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier) for body, balanced with one-third Chardonnay for elegance. It has a fine persistent sparkle and golden Champagne colour.

Mercier Champagne £34.00
A lovely Champagne of a straw yellow colour. Its nose is dominated by seeded white fruit. The high proportion of Pinot Noir grapes is expressed in a palate of ripe apple and pear aromas which climax in a delightfully fresh finish.

Saumur Brut £16.90
Close alternative to Champagne, from the Loire. Dry, with good fruit and body.

Saumur Rose Brut £18.40
Made by the traditional Champagne method. Prettily pink, dryish, attractively fruity.

White Wines

Muscadet Sauterjeau Reserve £16.40
A slight lemony acidity, dry and light white wine. Particularly popular in France. Ideal with seafood.

Macon-Lugny Les Genievres, Louis Latour £19.60
Opulent, rich, with a flowery bouquet and lovely honey, apple and nutty flavours on the palate. The wine is frank and expresses aromas of lemon, acacia and honey.

Chablis Domaine du Colombier (France, Burgundy) £19.90
A medium bodied dry white wine which tastes very fresh with a steely back bone typical of a quality Chablis. Well balanced on the palate.

Chardonnay, Morning Fog, Wente £18.65
Aromas of green apple and tropical fruits, balanced by a subtle oak and vanilla from barrel ageing.

Sauvignon Blanc, Riversdale, Marlborough £17.20
This luscious premium Sauvignon Blanc combines intense white peach and nectarine aromas with beautiful fresh fruit to provide a full palate and lingering finish.

Red Wines

Waterstone Bridge Reserve Merlot (Australia) £16.40
Sweet fruit flavours of Plums, Blackberries and Raspberries, all combining to give a soft well balanced style. Soft round and elegant.

Rioja Marques De Caceras Crianza (Spain) £19.90
This full bodied red wine is aged in oak barrels for 15-18 months, and then in the bottle for a similar period. It is a wine with pleasant tannins and an intense bouquet, vivid ruby red in colour and well balanced.

Fleurie Domaine Matray (France, Beaujolais) £23.40
Light and one of the most luscious fruity red wines. The aroma is strong, the wine tastes fruity and silky and remains brilliantly translucent.

Pinot Noir Sepia, Reserva, Vistamar Wines £16.40
Refined and complex, this Pinot Noir from the mountains of Chile has more body than most but still holds that light elegance of a Pinot Noir.

Cote Du Rhone "Domaine" £15.90
Clear and bright in colour this wine is rich and soft with well balanced fruit and hints of spice.

Don David Malbec, Michel Torino £19.30
A brilliant deep red with hints of violet. Matured slowly in French oak, this 100% Malbec is beautifully balanced with succulent ripe and velvet smooth tannins. A favourite of the proprietor!

Barolo Villadoria £38.40
One of Italy's finest wines, a full bodied red wine, characterised by it's strong bouquet. This wine has been aged for three to four years.

Chardonnay Torrontes Finca Vieja £11.90
A pale yellow wine with an attractive fragrant nose of citrus and honey. A fresh fruity palate, not too dry with a pleasant after taste.

Sauvignon Blanc Tariquet £11.40
On the nose, fine floral, ripe citrus, and mineral aromas come together nicely. The round palate is full of fruit flavors with great intensity and definition, and a beautiful refreshing finish.

Pinot Grigio Principato, Cavit (Pavia) (Italy) £12.50
The most popular white wine from the north of Italy. Fresh, floral and fruity with just a suggestion of golden apples on the palate, good weight and depth.

Rose D'Anjou (France, Loire Valley) £11.90
A very easy to drink at any time medium Rose wine, full of delicious fruit and flavour.

Pinot Grigio Rose, "Ancora" (Pavia) (Italy) £12.30
Fresh and dry. A classic Italian wine with a twist of pink. Crisp and refreshing with light fruit flavours.

Red - Shiraz Malbec Finca Vieja £11.90
Lively intense red colour with an aroma of raspberries and plums. The palate is soft and easy with plenty of fruit and a long pleasant finish.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Los Boldos £13.60
Warm red fruits on the nose. Slightly charry finish. Big and clean with good vibrant fruit with oak and tannin.

Kleindal Pinotage, South Africa £12.20
This classic variety typically offers flavours of banana with plums and a touch of vanilla from the oak. Its long lingering finish is completed by soft tannins and flavours of wild berries.



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
