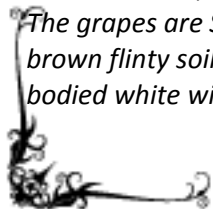
Champagne and Sparkling Wines

- 1. Veuve Clicquot** £44.95
Loved all over the world for its crisp, full flavours and consistent quality. This classical dry Champagne is a blend of two-thirds black grapes (Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier) for body, balanced with one-third Chardonnay for elegance. It has a fine persistent sparkle and golden Champagne colour.
- 2. Saumur Brut** £15.95
Close alternative to Champagne, from the Loire. Dry, with good fruit and body.
- 3. Saumur Rose Brut** £15.95
Made by the traditional Champagne method. Prettily pink, dryish, attractively fruity.



White Wines

- 4. Muscadet Sautejeau Reserve** £15.40
A slight lemony acidity, dry and light white wine. Particularly popular in France. Ideal with seafood.
- 5. Macon-Lugny Les Genievres, Louis Latour** £18.50
Opulent, rich, with a flowery bouquet and lovely honey, apple and nutty flavours on the palate. The wine is frank and expresses aromas of lemon, acacia and honey.
- 6. Chablis Domaine du Colombier (France, Burgundy)** £18.45
A medium bodied dry white wine which tastes very fresh with a steely back bone typical of a quality Chablis. Well balanced on the palate.
- 7. Chardonnay, Morning Fog, Wente** £17.60
Aromas of green apple and tropical fruits, balanced by a subtle oak and vanilla from barrel ageing.
- 8. Pouilly Fume, Domaine de Noizet** £24.85
Only selected grapes are used for this richly sumptuous exclusive wine in its distinctive bottle.
- 9. Sauvignon Blanc, Riversdale, Marlborough** £16.60
This luscious premium Sauvignon Blanc combines intense white peach and nectarine aromas with beautiful fresh fruit to provide a full palate and lingering finish.
- 10. Sancerre, Domaine Les Chaumes** £26.80
The grapes are Sauvignon Blanc, the vines are grown from a brown flinty soil, chalky and well drained. This Sancerre is a full bodied white wine, lively and smooth.







Red Wines

- 11. Waterstone Bridge Reserve Merlot (Australia)** £15.40
Sweet fruit flavours of Plums, Blackberries and Raspberries, all combining to give a soft well balanced style. Soft round and elegant.
- 12. Rioja Marques De Caceras Crianza (Spain)** £18.90
This full bodied red wine is aged in oak barrels for 15-18 months, and then in the bottle for a similar period. It is a wine with pleasant tannins and an intense bouquet, vivid ruby red in colour and well balanced.
- 13. Fleurie Domaine Matray (France, Beaujolais)** £22.00
Light and one of the most luscious fruity red wines. The aroma is strong, the wine tastes fruity and silky and remains brilliantly translucent.
- 14. Chateau Tour Calon, Montagne, St.Emilion, Grand Cru Reserve** £22.00
Aged in oak barrels, this is fruity and bold, but still an elegant and voluptuous wine. The colour is deep and bright; the structure is well balanced and the finish very pleasant!
- 15. Pinot Noir Rossendale** £17.80
This pinot noir has aromas of fresh raspberries, game and spicy oak with a soft lingering finish. Excellent drinking with game and red meats
- 16. Cote Du Rhone "Domaine Louiset"** £14.95
Clear and bright in colour this wine is rich and soft with well balanced fruit and hints of spice.
- 17. Don David Malbec, Michel Torino** £18.20
A brilliant deep red with hints of violet. Matured slowly in French oak, this 100% Malbec is beautifully balanced with succulent ripe and velvet smooth tannins. A favourite of the proprietor!



Connoisseurs Selection

Something truly special for those seeking a finer wine to accompany their meal.

- Montagny Premier Cru, Domaine de Montorge** £31.00
From the Cote Chalonnaise, buttery style, crisp acidity, well made Chardonnay.
- Meursault, Albert Bichot** £45.00
Typically nutty, with soft aromas, a rich cream body, solid backbone and good depth.
- Barolo Villadoria** £38.40
One of Italy's finest wines, a full bodied red wine, characterised by it's strong bouquet. This wine has been aged for three to four years.
- Chateauneuf-Du-Pape, "Domaine du Vieux Telegraphe, "La Crau"** £47.90
This Chateauneuf du Pape is a full bodied red wine from the Rhone Valley region, where the winds combine with the warmth of the sun and the richness of their "terroir" gives it a velvety and soft bouquet.

- 18. Chardonnay Torrontes Finca Vieja** £10.25
A pale yellow wine with an attractive fragrant nose of citrus and honey. A fresh fruity palate, not too dry with a pleasant after taste.
- 19. Sauvignon Blanc Tariquet** £10.70
On the nose, fine floral, ripe citrus, and mineral aromas come together nicely. The round palate is full of fruit flavors with great intensity and definition, and a beautiful refreshing finish.
- 20. Pinot Grigio Principato, Cavit (Pavia) (Italy)** £11.80
The most popular white wine from the north of Italy. Fresh, floral and fruity with just a suggestion of golden apples on the palate, good weight and depth.
- 21. Rose D'Anjou (France, Loire Valley)** £10.95
A very easy to drink at any time medium Rose wine, full of delicious fruit and flavour.
- 22. Pinot Grigio Rose, "Ancora" (Pavia) (Italy)** £11.60
Fresh and dry. A classic Italian wine with a twist of pink. Crisp and refreshing with light fruit flavours.
- 23. Red - Shiraz Malbec Finca Vieja** £10.25
Lively intense red colour with an aroma of raspberries and plums. The palate is soft and easy with plenty of fruit and a long pleasant finish.
- 24. Cabernet Sauvignon, Los Boldos** £12.80
Warm red fruits on the nose. Slightly charray finish. Big and clean with good vibrant fruit with oak and tannin.
- 25. Kleindal Pinotage, South Africa** £11.50 .
This classic variety typically offers flavours of banana with plums and a touch of vanilla from the oak. Its long lingering finish is completed by soft tannins and flavours of wild berries.
