

# WINE CELLAR

## Champagne and Sparkling Wines

- 1. Laurent Perrier Champagne, Brut £29.95**  
The colour is a pale golden hue. The nose is fresh and delicate with hints of citrus. Perfectly balanced with crisp flavours and finesse.
- 2. Prosecco, "Lunetta", Cavit (Italy) £14.50**  
A light and fruity sparkling wine with small bubbles to tantalise your taste~buds. A delicious sparkling wine from Trentino Italy.
- 3. Saumur Rose Brut £14.35**  
Made by the traditional Champagne method. Prettily pink, dryish, attractively fruity.



## White Wines

- 4. Muscadet Sautejeau Reserve (France, Loire Valley) £11.30**  
A slight lemony acidity, dry and light white wine. Particularly popular in France.
- 5. Montana Sauvignon Blanc (New Zealand) £14.90**  
This dry wine has an exhilarating blend of ripe gooseberry flavours and tropical fruits with a crisp and refreshing acidity on the finish.
- 6. Chablis Domaine du Colombier (France, Burgundy) £18.45**  
A medium bodied dry white wine which tastes very fresh with a steely back bone typical of a quality Chablis.
- 7. Chardonnay Volandas (Chile) £10.95**  
This is a medium white brilliant yellow in colour. It has intense aromas of green apples and tropical fruits with a backdrop of vanilla. The taste is fresh with a medium and balanced body.
- 8. Piesporter Michelsberg, Schmitt Sohne (Germany) £10.40**  
Lightly elegant, crisp, fruity and attractively off dry. This wine originates from one of the prettiest riverside Mosel villages in Germany.
- 9. Pinot Grigio Principato, Cavit (Pavia) (Italy) £11.45**  
The most popular white wine from the north of Italy. Fresh, floral and fruity with just a suggestion of golden apples on the palate, good weight and depth.



## Rose Wines

- 10. Pinot Grigio Rose, "Ancora" (Pavia) (Italy) £11.60**  
Fresh and dry. A classic Italian wine with a twist of pink. Crisp and refreshing with light fruit flavours.
- 11. Rose D'Anjou (France, Loire Valley) £10.95**  
A very easy to drink at any time medium Rose wine, full of delicious fruit and flavour.

## Red Wines



- 12. Waterstone Bridge Reserve Merlot (Australia) £13.40**  
Sweet fruit flavours of Plums, Blackberries and Raspberries, all combining to give a soft well balanced style. Soft round and elegant.
- 13. Rioja Marques De Caceras Crianza (Spain) £15.90**  
This full bodied red wine is aged in oak barrels for 15-18 months, and then in the bottle for a similar period. It is a wine with pleasant tannins and an intense bouquet, vivid ruby red in colour and well balanced.
- 14. Fleurie Domaine Matray (France, Beaujolais) £16.40**  
Light and one of the most luscious fruity red wines. The aroma is strong, the wine tastes fruity and silky and remains brilliantly translucent.
- 15. Malbec “Vinas de Barrancas”, Finca Flichman (Argentina) £11.20**  
A grape variety widely planted and nowadays regarded as an Argentinean speciality. Of medium weight, with an aroma of great complexity, slightly peppery finish and well balanced.
- 16. Cote Du Rhone “Domaine Louiset” £10.45**  
Clear and bright in colour this wine is rich and soft with well balanced fruit and hints of spice.
- 17. Haut Medoc Tannais Oliver 2004 (France, Bordeaux) £18.95**  
This dark red wine has a powerful nose of fresh red fruits. It is well balanced and full bodied but with silky smooth tannins.
- 18. Cabernet Sauvignon, Misiones de Rengo (Chile) £11.50**  
A ruby red medium bodied wine, with subtle floral aromas. The palate is elegant, flavoursome and well rounded with a soft finish.
